- Review developers' test plans to ensure comprehensive coverage.
- Document, analyze and report (oral and written) test results (including bugs) and recommend corrective action.
- Isolate, reproduce, manage, and maintain defects and test case databases, and verify fixes.
- Work with relevant teams to troubleshoot issues.
- Conduct post-release/ post-implementation testing.
- Work with cross-functional teams to ensure quality throughout the software development lifecycle.
- Identify tests to perform to ensure end-to-end service performance from key stakeholder perspective.
- Facilitate the study of problems and needs to determine how the system testing assures
 information technology can best solve the problems and accomplish improvements in the business.
- Identify opportunities for process improvement or process re-engineering as well as software optimisation.
- Conduct sprint estimation, planning, and managing development tasks as well as report in progress as per Sprint predetermined frequencies.
- Advise on solutions to conform to best practices.
- Compliance with PIC policies, procedures and standards.
- Maintain, share and transfer product, process and systems knowledge to Business and IT stakeholders.
