

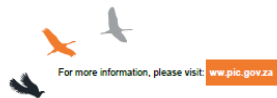

SECTION 18 POPI NOTICE- INFORMED CONSENT DOCUMENT

INTRODUCTION

- The Public Investment Corporation SOC LTD (“PIC”) is committed to protecting your privacy and recognises that it needs to comply with statutory requirements in the collection, processing and distribution of personal information.
- Section 14 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, provides that everyone has the right to privacy; furthermore the Protection of Personal Information Act, 4 OF 2013(POPI) further reiterates that the right to privacy includes a right to protection against the unlawful collection, retention, dissemination and use of personal information.
- According to section 18 of the Act, if personal information is collected, the responsible party must take reasonably practicable steps to ensure that the data subject is made aware of the information being collected and where the information is not collected from the data subject, the source from which it is collected, subject to certain exceptions, including those where the collection of information is required for a contractual or legal purpose and / or is required for the purpose of protecting the legitimate interests of the Company.

SECTION 18 DETAILS

- Following this, The PIC would like to acquire Informed Consent from you (the “Data Subject”) before it collects from you, any of your personal information.
- In terms of Section 18 of POPI the Company is obliged to provide you with the following information when collecting personal information from you:
- Type of information being collected: ID numbers; names and surnames of applicant and applicant’s parents/guardian; contact information of Guardian/parents/applicant; proof of household income of parents/guardian/applicant; confirmation of academic results and current level of education; proof of residence.
- Nature or category of the information: The information will be collected, evaluated and stored on the PIC premises in Pretoria.

- Purpose: the information is being collected for evaluation of suitable candidates for award of a bursary from the PIC.
- Source: If the information is not collected directly from the applicant (data subject) it will be provided by the applicant's guardian/parent.
- Voluntary or mandatory: The supply of the information by the data subject is voluntary.
- Contractual requirement: The information is required for completion of the bursary application form.
- Consequences of not providing: Failing to provide the requested information will mean that we are unable to properly consider the bursary application.
- Recipients of information: The recipient of the information is the PIC and any verification agencies the PIC may use to verify the contents of the information provided;
- The PIC has put in place the necessary safeguards to secure the electronic and paper based applications received.
- Any leakage of information will be report to the Information Regulation in due compliance with the Act
- Access and right to amend: The applicant or the applicant's guardians/parents have the right of access to and the right to rectify the information collected;
- Complaints: The applicant may lodge a written complaint with the PIC's Information Officer ("Information Officer") in terms of section 63 of the Act. Should the complaint not be satisfactorily resolved the applicant has the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Regulator.
