Investment Background

Botshilu is part of Phelang Bonolo Healthcare Group (PBH), a group which was established in 2006 by Dr Jacky Rampedi and has acquired 4 hospital licenses totalling more than 350 beds. Botshilu is a multi-disciplinary hospital with a key focus on women and children. The key target market for Botshilu is the working class and middle class in the catchment area of Soshanguve and the surrounding areas.

Investment Rationale

The investment provides much-needed healthcare infrastructure in a historically disadvantaged area. It aids transformation and BBBEE in a sector dominated by large companies who have enjoyed dominance of the healthcare sector. The investment also supports local small businesses through the provision of various non-clinical hospital services.

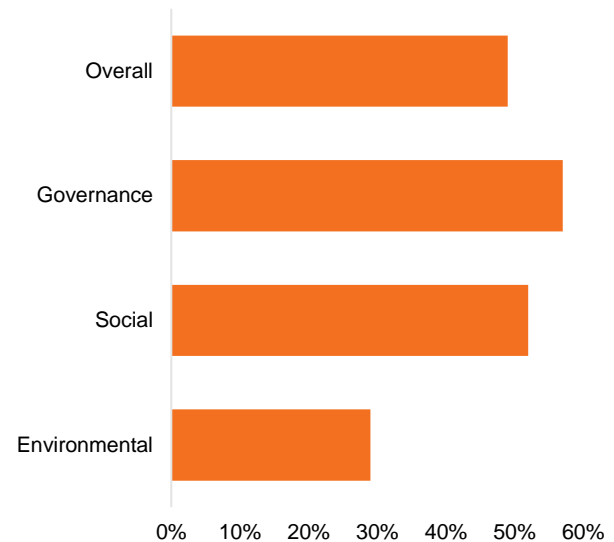
